

Clymping Beach January 2026

In response to Storm Goretti, the Environment Agency (EA) is currently developing an initial proposal to help protect the properties that may be affected and to carry out recovery works in the next couple of weeks. The EA are also looking at the possibility of pushing the shingle onto the bottom of Climping Street without an order in place, for the better protection of those properties.

The EA have notified the Parish Council that they will be working on the Clymping frontage bund starting next Monday 2nd February for 2 weeks. The bottom of Climing Street will be temporarily blocked off for safety reasons, so there will be no parking available for two weeks. Warning signage will be in place. Access to Mill Lane will remain open.

The work will involve moving the shingle bund landward over the bottom of Climping Street limiting the current area in which people park.
